

- ❶ **Norfolk Wildlife Trust Nature Reserve** (right) is open year round 10am-5pm. There is a small charge for entry; free for children and NWT members. The visitor centre is open April to September. Call 01692 598276 during the season for further information. A wildlife trail by electric boat operates May to September.
- ❷ **Sutton Pottery** is a small studio workshop established by Malcolm Flatman in 1977. He uses the potter's wheel and the fire of a gas kiln to create a large range of 'reduction' stoneware entirely by hand. Usually open on weekdays (excluding bank holidays) 9am-1pm and 2-6pm throughout the year.
- ❸ **Sutton Mill**, an historic corn mill, is Britain's tallest and was in use until 1940.
- ❹ **St Mary's Church** is an Augustinian Priory recorded in the Domesday Book. The present church dates from 1240 and contains many ancient artefacts.
